

House of Commons Page Program

Deadline – Monday, December 4th, 2017

Details: 40 students graduating from high schools and CEGEPS are selected from across Canada to participate in the Page Program. These are students that are first year undergraduate students who work in the House of Commons for one year. Pages are responsible for a wide range of tasks directly related to Chamber activities, and can broaden their knowledge of Parliament by playing a role in the rich traditions of the Canadian parliamentary system. Contract would begin late August 2018 and students are required to work a minimum of 15 hours per week. There is an annual salary of \$16,088, and a final lump sum of \$1200 upon completion of their contract.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident
- Be graduating from high school and starting full-time studies at 1 of the 4 universities in the National Capital Region in September 2018
- Have obtained an overall average of at least 80% in Grade 11 and maintain that average
- Be able to orally communicate fluently in both French and English
